Q: Age criteria for kids participation

A: For safety and security reasons **kids below 15 years are not allowed** to participate in the event. To all registered kids above 15, wearing a valid bib is mandatory as there will be no entry to the venue without a valid bib.

Q: Where is the start/finish point?

A: The start/finish point is KTPO, Whitefield, https://g.co/kgs/zVrV7dE

Q: What does the race route encompass?

A: Refer to the category wise route map here - https://sapraceinfo.icsevents.in/

Q: What to expect enroute?

The route will have 5 hydration stations at strategic points, toilets for male and female runners, entertainment through the route, kilometer markers to let you know the distance you have already run, and 2 medical ambulances for emergencies. There will be ample amount of volunteers enroute, route marshals on 2 wheelers to lead you throughout the route. Most importantly, there will be photographers who will be clicking your running pics. So keep your smile on!!!

Q: Should I provide emergency contact information?

A: Yes, please write your emergency contact name and number at the back of your bib.

Q: How should I wear the bib?

A: The best position for the bib is across your abdomen, not your chest. Do not put it too low as it may hinder your running. Use safety pins to secure the bib. Start with one of the top corners first, then secure the bottom corners. Double-check that the placement of the bib does not hinder your motion.

Q: Can I run without the BIB?

A: No. No entry into the venue without valid bib.

O: Can I wear someone else's bib or have someone else wear mine?

A: No. These are grounds for disqualification.

Q: Can someone run on the route without a bib, even if they are a registered participant?

A: No.

Q: Are there parking facilities available at event venue - KTPO?

A: Yes. Parking entry to KTPO is restricted to KTPO Gate No 1 & KTPO Gate No. 2 on the Kundanahalli Main Road, after Kundanahalli Metro Station. No vehicles will be allowed from KTPO main entrance. We strongly recommend you to carpool to the venue. Expect some wait time and estimated time to reach the holding area is about 15 mins.

Q: What are the parking options for SAP Employees?

A: SAP employees will be able to park their vehicles at MLCP (Multi-Level Car Parking), SAP Whitefield Campus. Entry will be only from SAP Gate 1 or Gate 3. Gate 4 will remain closed until end of the event. Carry your SAP ID Card for access to the campus for parking.

Q: Will there be a baggage counter?

A: Yes, there will be a baggage counter with very limited capacity if you wish to drop off any bags you are carrying with you. However, it is recommended not to carry any baggage unless absolutely necessary. Please do not leave any valuables in the bags. SAP will not be responsible for any loss of your personal jewellery, accessories or belongings.

Note that baggage counters will not hold helmets. The location of the baggage counter is in the parking area, just before entry to the holding area.

Q: Will there be traffic on the route?

A: The route will have regulated traffic to provide you with a safe running route. However, occasional breakouts and people ignoring the rules may occur. Please remain aware of your surroundings as a runner.

Q: What should I do in case of an emergency?

A: In case of an emergency, pls call the medical helpline number **87920 63003 and +91 87924 95270** or inform the nearest aid station, route marshals, or volunteers, and they will provide the required help.

Q: What medical support will be available?

A: Ambulances and medical support teams will be accessible on the route. Physiotherapy services will be available in the finish area through the official Physio Partner. First aid will also be available at all designated aid stations.

Q: Will I receive a Finisher medal?

A: Yes, Finisher medals will be provided only to those who finish the race and have their bibs present.

Q: How will I receive my race timing information?

A: Finishers will receive a text message with their provisional timing on their registered mobile numbers.

Q: Where can I find the final race timing?
